4. Provide specific information to clarify any checklist items that you wish to highlight. Materials and features may be noted in a general fashion on the checklist.
5. On a separate piece of paper – not greater than two pages double sided– Address each of the six principles of sustainable design and explain why your project is an example of that principle:

Principle 1- Respect for the Wisdom of Natural Systems – The Biomimicry Principle

Principle 2- Respect for People – The Human Vitality Principle

Principle 3- Respect for Place – The Ecosystem/Bioregion Principle

Principle 4- Respect for the Cycle of Life – The “Seven Generations” Principle

Principle 5- Respect for Energy and Natural Resources – The Conservation and Renewable Resources Principle

Principle 6- Respect for Process – The Holistic Thinking Principle

6. A visual representation of the project, no larger than 8.5 x 11 inches. Please include a CD with photos of the project. Photos will not be returned unless a self-addressed stamp envelope is included. By submitting the photo(s) you are authorizing full rights to use the photos for any promotional materials.
